CCF Partition systems:

Symmetry, Prima , Excel

The above partition systems comprise mainly of extruded aluminium, or cold rolled steel, polyester powder painted, anodised or galvanised sections. Some glazing sections and skirtings may also be uPVC. None of these materials give rise for concern as described in the above regulation. Infill panels may vary but are usually plasterboard. In these circumstances British Gypsum Plasterboard safety data sheet SDS 09 applies. These products are not classed as hazardous. General good trade working practices should be used when constructing CCF partition systems. The following guide for users may be helpful.

GUIDE FOR USER

Product Use

1. Always use products for the purpose and in the manner in which they were intended. No product supplied is suitable for human consumption.
2. Always keep dust to a minimum, where necessary, use respiratory face mask and protective clothing. Refer to HSE Guidance note EH40 for exposure standard.
3. If irritation occurs, rinse well with clean cold water, wash thoroughly. The use of barrier creams can sometimes prevent skin irritation. If symptoms persist obtain medical advice. In the event of eye contamination or if any product is swallowed seek immediate medical attention.
4. When working overhead or when cutting metal products, the use of protective eye glasses is advisable.
5. Metal products may be sharp, due care should be taken and protective gloves worn where necessary.
6. Metal is a good conductor of electricity. Proper precautions should be taken when working near live power lines or electrical equipment.
7. Plastic and metal can become electrically charged. Static electricity may cause sparks when earthed.
8. Always use sealants, adhesives and jointing compounds in a well ventilated area. Products may give off fumes during the drying process. Avoid inhalation of vapours.
9. Electrical equipment and power hand tools must only be used in accordance with manufacturers instructions. Maintenance, including the fitting of electrical plugs, must only be undertaken by suitably trained personnel.

10. Personal hygiene is important, always wash hands well, particularly before eating food. The need for adequate standards of hygiene must be maintained
